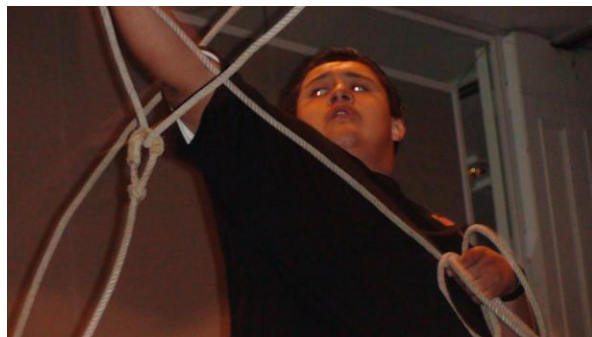
**But the fun doesn't stop here...spectators will also join in the fun and participate in fun activities hosted by your state officer team!**

3. Submit a completed application by March 2<sup>nd</sup> via email to [president@cal-hosa.org](mailto:president@cal-hosa.org) or by fax to (916) 471-6538. The **first 15 applications** received and approved will be chosen to perform in the Talent Show Extravaganza.
4. Approved participants will be notified of their selection on March 7<sup>th</sup> via email.
5. Submit your application as soon as possible and reserve your spot today!

## California HOSA Night of Mystery Talent Show & Fundraiser Extravaganza

### Rules and Regulations

1. Eligibility - This event is open to all California HOSA registered conference attendees.
2. Dress Code for Participants - Participants must use common sense in selecting their performance attire. Participants are encouraged to consider their school dress code as guidelines.
3. Dress Code for Spectators – Spectators should dress in HOSA spirit attire (HOSA t-shirts); Inappropriate alterations will not be tolerated. Spectators are encouraged to consider their school dress code as guidelines.
4. Time limits - Performances are strictly limited to 3:30 minutes. Performers are allotted some time for stage set up and clean up (approximately 1:30 total).
5. Equipment - Participants are responsible for providing their own equipment. Only one microphone and one plug-in source for sound will be provided. We are not responsible for any theft/damage to any equipment before, during, or after the show.
6. Music - Any music to be played must be on a CD and clearly labeled with (1) Performer's Name (2) Performer's Phone Number, (3) A track number specified for the DJ. Performers are responsible for claiming their CD at the end of the show.
7. Songs - Any songs played should be clean and appropriate. No foul language or inappropriate content.
8. Safety First - Acts that are dangerous or a possible liability (break dancing, head spins, flips, knives, fire, smoke, ) are not allowed.
9. Comedy - Comedy acts should consist of clean, family-friendly material.
10. Approval - Advisers must review talent show acts and attire before presenting at the conference. (Any act deemed inappropriate will not be allowed to participate in the talent show.)
11. Respect - All participants and spectators are asked to be respectful. Booing, name calling, or any other form of disrespect will not be tolerated. Make responsible decisions to ensure an enjoyable experience for all!
